Located an hour outside of Miami at 3200 Northeast 26th Street, the Beach House is a luxury residency that the City of Fort Lauderdale awarded the 2018 Community Appearance Award for its beautiful curb appeal.

According to the City of Fort Lauderdale's website, the residency was given the honor because it enhances the city's visual image and economic vitality.

The Beach House includes four types of single family homes that start at \$1.5 million that are available to buy. The homes include three to four bedrooms along with a large terrace.
